System Requirements

The Clay Tablet Connector for Adobe Experience Manager ("AEM") must be installed on the AEM Author server. The Clay Tablet Connector for AEM supports AEM versions 5.6.1 and higher.

The Clay Tablet Connector for AEM has no additional hardware or software requirements beyond those of AEM. For detailed requirements, refer to the appropriate version of the *Adobe Experience Manager Technical Requirements*.

Issues Fixed in This Release

Issue ID	Description
AEM-439	The Translation Queue now loads properly when there are over 40,000 users. Previously, the Translation Queue took a very long time to load and displayed errors in this scenario.
AEM-445	You can now update the translation memory for translated pages that you updated, even if the Connector cannot verify the translated page as updated. This means that the Update Remote TM option in the Page tab of Sidekick is always available.
	Previously, you could not update the translation memory for translated pages that you updated, if the Connector could not verify that those pages were updated.
	To configure this change, so that the Update Remote TM option in the Page tab of Sidekick is always available:
	1. In CRXDE, navigage to /etc/ctctranslation.
	2. Add a debug node.
	3. Add the isForceUTMDbCheck string property with the enabled value.
AEM-448	The Connector now records a page that was translated completely with a local TM (translation memory) as having been translated. This enables the Update TM button in the Translation Status page.
	Previously, the Connector did not record a page that was translated completely with a local TM (translation memory) as having been translated. This disabled the Update TM button in the Translation Status page for those pages.
AEM-453	Custom search agents are now available for selection, by default, for all item types, in the Search Using Agent dropdown list in the Item Type page of the Bulk Translation wizard. Previously, custom search agents were not available by for selection by default for any item types.
AEM-454	The Bulk Translation wizard now loads properly when adding more than 10,000 items for translation. Previously, the Bulk Translation wizard timed out in this scenario.
