The Connector enables you to automate sending and retrieving content from your Adobe Experience Manager CMS, which dramatically reduces the effort required to create, maintain, and publish Web content in multiple languages.

System Requirements

The Clay Tablet Translation Connector for Adobe Experience Manager ("AEM") must be installed on the AEM Author server. The Clay Tablet Translation Connector for AEM supports AEM versions 5.6.1 and higher.

The Clay Tablet Translation Connector for AEM has no additional hardware or software requirements beyond those of AEM. For detailed requirements, refer to the appropriate version of the *Adobe Experience Manager Technical Requirements*.

What's New?

On the **Team Profiles** page, both AEM users and AEM groups can now be added to a team profile. Previously, only AEM users could be added to a team profile.

Issue ID	Description
AEM-6	After updating translated content and refreshing the page, the Update Remote TM option (formerly called the CTC Update TM option) in the Page tab of Sidekick is now available. Previously, after updating translated content and refreshing the page, this option was unavailable.
AEM-11	In the Add New Profile dialog box, which opens from the Team Profiles page, the Member label is now spelled correctly. Previously, this label was spelled incorrectly.
AEM-15	The CTC Update TM option in the Page tab of Sidekick was renamed to Update Remote TM.
AEM-19	In the Bulk Translation wizard, the page navigation buttons at the bottom of each page are now in the following order: Cancel, Back , and Next . Previously, these buttons were in the following order: Back, Next , and Cancel .
AEM-26	In the Translation Log page, clicking Download selected log files (formerly called Download checked log files), when no log files are selected, now displays a warning message without a spelling mistake. Previously, this warning message had a spelling mistake.
AEM-27	In the CQ Server URL section of the Configuration page, the embedded help text is now correct. Previously, this embedded text help was unclear and had grammatical errors.
AEM-29	In the Translation Platform section of the Configuration page, the formatting around the Public Platform sub-section is now consistent. The box around this sub-section no longer overlaps the box around the Translation Platform section.
AEM-30	When using the Google Chrome browser, the Team Profiles menu item is now displayed properly under the Admin Tools menu in the Clay Tablet Connector rail. Previously, when using Google Chrome with AEM, the Team Profiles menu item was not displayed in the proper position under the Admin Tools menu.

Issues Fixed in This Release

Issue ID	Description
AEM-31	Clicking Test in the Translation Platform section of the Configuration page when there is no data in this section, now displays the correct error message. Previously, clicking Test when there was no data in that section displayed HTML code.
AEM-32	When using the Google Chrome browser, the Component Mapping menu item is now displayed in a single line under the Admin Tools menu in the Clay Tablet Connector rail. Previously, when using Google Chrome with AEM, the Component Mapping menu item was split into two lines under the Admin Tools menu.
AEM-34	Clicking Test in the Email Notification section of the Configuration page when the [SMTP Auth] User or the [SMTP Auth] Password fields are blank now displays appropriate error messages. Previously, clicking Test in this section when these fields were blank displayed inaccurate error messages.
AEM-35	Clicking Test in the Folder and Permission section of the Configuration page when the fields in this section are blank now displays appropriate error messages. Previously, clicking Test in this section when these fields were blank displayed inaccurate error messages.
AEM-36	The error messages that open after clicking Test in the Email Notification section of the Configuration page when the [SMTP Auth] User or the [SMTP Auth] Password fields are blank now have correct capitalization. Previously, these error messages had incorrect capitalization.
AEM-37	The formatting of error messages originating from the JDBC SQL Connection section of the Configuration page is now correct. Previously, error messages displayed for this section contained additional brackets.
AEM-38	In the Folder and Permission section of the Configuration page, the formatting around the Test button for the Data Folder field is now displayed in a consistent position in the following browsers: Microsoft Internet Explorer, Mozilla Firefox, and Google Chrome. Previously, this button was in different positions in different browsers.
AEM-39	Improved wording in error messages originating from the JDBC SQL Connection section of the Configuration page.
AEM-40	In the Language Mapping page, in the CTC Language dropdown list, Chinese_Hong_Kong is now displayed correctly. Previously, this language was displayed as Chinese_HongKong.

AEM-41	In the Language Mapping page, in the CTC Language dropdown list, English_Hong_Kong is now displayed correctly. Previously, this language was displayed as English_HongKong.
AEM-42	In the Language Mapping page, in the CTC Language dropdown list, Panjabi is now displayed once, and Punjabi_Pakistan is now displayed. Previously, both these languages were displayed as Panjabi, which was displayed in this list twice.
AEM-43	In the Language Mapping page, in the CTC Language dropdown list, Arabic_Middle_East is now displayed correctly. Previously, this language was displayed as Arabic_MiddleEast.
AEM-44	In the Language Mapping page, in the CTC Language dropdown list, Dhivehi is now displayed correctly. Previously, this language was displayed as Divehi.
AEM-45	In the Language Mapping page, in the CTC Language dropdown list, Macedonian_FYROM is now displayed correctly. Previously, this language was displayed as FYO_Macedonian.
AEM-46	In the Language Mapping page, in the CTC Language dropdown list, Pashto is now displayed correctly. Previously, this language was displayed as Pushto.
AEM-47	In the Language Mapping page, in the CTC Language dropdown list, Rhaeto_Romance is now displayed correctly. Previously, this language was displayed as Raeto_Romance.
AEM-48	In the Language Mapping page, in the CTC Language dropdown list, Sinhala_Sri_Lanka is now displayed correctly. Previously, this language was displayed as Sinhalese (Sri Lanka).
AEM-49	In the Language Mapping page, in the CTC Language dropdown list, Spanish_Latin_ America is now displayed correctly. Previously, this language was displayed as Spanish_ LatinAmerica.
AEM-50	In the Language Mapping page, in the CTC Language dropdown list, Uyghur is now displayed correctly. Previously, this language was displayed as Uighur.
AEM-51	In the Language Mapping page, in the CTC Language dropdown list, Uzbek_Cyrillic is now displayed correctly. Previously, this language was displayed as uz_Cryrl.

Issue ID	Description
AEM-53	In the Language Mapping page, in the CTC Language dropdown list, Sorbian is now displayed correctly. Previously, this language was displayed as wen-DE.
AEM-54	In the Language Mapping page, clicking the Del button to remove the first row from the list, and then clicking Add to add a new row to the list, now displays all expected fields in the new row. Previously, after removing the first row from the list, and then adding a new row to the list, the new row was missing fields in the Type, CTC Language , and the Sort # columns.
AEM-55	In the Language Mapping page, the Del button is now displayed after adding a new language. Previously, this button was not displayed.
AEM-56	In the Language Mapping page, the minus icon beside the Del button and the plus icons beside the Add buttons are now properly aligned. Previously, the tops of the icons were aligned with the tops of the buttons.
AEM-58	In the Language Mapping page, when deleting a language, the confirmation box no longer displays brackets around the language code to delete. Previously, when deleting a language, the confirmation box displayed brackets around the language code to delete.
AEM-59	In the Component Mapping page, the Export button is now located below the Configured Fields for Translation input box on the left side. Previously, the Export button was above the Configured Fields for Translation input box, at the top of the page, which was inconsistent with the placement of this button on other pages.
AEM-60	In the Component Mapping page, the Delete button is now the same size as the other buttons on the page. Previously, the Delete button was much bigger than the other buttons on the page.
AEM-61	In the Language Mapping page, the Del button now functions correctly. Previously, clicking the Del button sometimes removed the language in the row above the button, instead of removing the language in the same row as the button.
AEM-63	In the Collect Fields for Translation from Path section of the Component Mapping page, the embedded help text was reworded. Previously, this embedded text help was unclear.
AEM-64	In the Component Mapping page, the embedded help text for the Configured Fields for Translation and the Collected Possible Property Fields for Translation sections is now correct. Previously, the embedded text help was unclear.

Issue ID	Description
AEM-66	In the <i>Clay Tablet Translation Connector for Adobe Experience Manager Installation and Configuration Guide</i> (March 11, 2014 version and later), in section 5.5, "Configuring Translation Providers and Account License Keys," the explanation of the Add, Cancel, Update , Delete , and Close buttons in the LSP & Keys page is complete and correct. In the Feb. 7, 2014 version of this guide, the explanation of the buttons in this section was incomplete.
AEM-67	In the LSP & Keys page, the plus icon beside the Add button in the LSP and Related Keys section is now properly aligned. Previously, the top of the icon was aligned with the top of the button.
AEM-68	The error message boxes displayed in the Admin Tools pages after clicking the Test buttons, when data is missing, are now a standard size with uniform behavior. Previously, these error message boxes were different sizes, and some closed automatically while others required clicking OK to close.
AEM-70	In the Component Mapping page, the section headings are now all the same size and color. Previously, the section headings were different sizes and colors.
AEM-75	In the Translation Log page, the Download checked log files button was renamed to Download selected log files .
AEM-76	In the Translation Log page, the Select All button is now to the left of the Unselect All button. Previously, the Unselect All button was to the left of the Select All button.
AEM-78	In the Internal Platform section of the Configuration page, the CTWS Server IP (or Domain Name) field was renamed to CTWS URL IP (or Domain Name).
AEM-86	A translation job for a single target language is now completed successfully. Previously, when a translation job for a single target language was sent for translation, the job was not completed successfully.
AEM-87	 In the Translation Queue, the following column headings were reworded, so that they are easier to understand: Created is now Created On. By is now Created By. Leave Unlock is now Leave Unlocked. Submit From is now Submitted From.

Issue ID	Description
AEM-91	In the TM Updates tab of the TM Update page, some column names were reworded and capitalized.
AEM-92	In the TM Updates tab of the TM Update page, the Remove Checked button was renamed to Remove Selected .
AEM-93	In the Pages page of the Bulk Translation wizard, the Re-count button was renamed to Update .
AEM-95	In the Pages page of the Bulk Translation wizard, clicking the Update button (formerly called the Re-count button) now updates the Total Checked Pages (for translation) field to display the correct number of pages with selected check boxes. Previously, clicking this button removed any pages from the list whose check boxes were not selected.
AEM-98	In the Status tab of the Translation Status page, when the page automatically refreshes, the sort order in the table is maintained. Previously, when this page automatically refreshed, the sort order in the table was not maintained.
AEM-108	The Bulk Translation wizard and Sidekick now have the correct amount of space at the top of the pages. Previously, there was too much space at the top of these pages.
AEM-109	The buttons for configuration testing in the Admin Tools pages are now all called Test . Previously, some of these buttons were called Test , while others were called Testing .
AEM-116	The Translation Queue no longer requires the user to click the Refresh button when applying a type or target filter to the list of displayed pages. Previously, after selecting a type or target from the corresponding dropdown lists, the user had to click the Refresh button to apply these filters.
AEM-132	In the Team Profiles page, the vertical spacing and button alignment is now correct. Previously, there was extra and inconsistent vertical spacing, and the buttons at the top of the page were too far to the right.
AEM-148	The Connector options are now displayed in Sidekick. Previously, the Connector options were not displayed in Sidekick for any Connector installation on AEM 6.0, or for a clean installation of the Connector on AEM 5.6.1.
