## **System Requirements**

The Clay Tablet Translation Connector for Adobe Experience Manager ("AEM") must be installed on the AEM Author server. The Clay Tablet Translation Connector for AEM supports AEM versions 6.0 and higher.

The Clay Tablet Translation Connector for AEM has no additional hardware or software requirements beyond those of AEM. For detailed requirements, refer to the appropriate version of the *Adobe Experience Manager Technical Requirements*.

Issue ID	Description
AEM-301	If the <b>Pickup Content From Blueprint Pages</b> CRX setting in CRXDE Lite is enabled, the Connector now synchronizes non-translatable properties, such as images, from a locked component. Previously, when this setting was enabled, the Connector did not synchronize non-translatable properties from a locked component.
	<b>Note:</b> If you are updating the Connector from a previous version, you must follow the steps below to apply this fix.
	1. On your AEM instance, open CRXDE Lite.
	2. In the navigation pane on the left, navigate to /etc/ctcpipelineconfig/ctcTranslationPipes.xml, and open this file.
	3. Locate the <handletranslateditempipe>section.</handletranslateditempipe>
	4. Add the following line, in bold, after the VerifyTranslatedItem line and before the PutTranslationBackToCQ5 line:

### **Known Issues**

Issue ID	Description
AEM-222	When opening a translated page from within the <b>Sites</b> section, the page opens in the AEM Classic UI instead of in the AEM Touch-Optimized UI.
AEM-284	The <b>Rollout Page</b> button in the <b>Page</b> tab in Sidekick is displayed twice.

Issue ID	Description
AEM-285	When using the AEM Touch-Optimized UI and tapping (clicking) <b>Tools</b> in the AEM rail, the Connector is not displayed in the inner rail.
AEM-286	The Adobe Experience Manager Web Console Components page lists 21 installed components instead of 20 installed components.
AEM-287	The CRXDE Lite interface lists 12 nodes under /etc/ctctranslation instead of 10 nodes.
AEM-312	<ul> <li>When both of the following conditions are true, the Connector does not send content for translation:</li> <li>The Target Pages Have Content in Source Language check box is selected in either the UI and Default Settings section of the Configuration page, the Options page of the Bulk Translation wizard, or the AEM Sidekick.</li> <li>The target page is not a Livecopy page.</li> </ul>
