#### **Overview**

Welcome to the Clay Tablet Connector for Sitecore (Connector). The Connector enables you to automate sending and retrieving content from your Sitecore CMS, which dramatically reduces the effort required to create, maintain, and publish Web content in multiple languages

### **System Requirements**

The Clay Tablet Connector for Sitecore (Connector) must be installed on the machine where Sitecore is installed. The Connector supports Sitecore versions 6.4 and higher, including all current releases.

The Connector has no additional hardware or software requirements beyond those of Sitecore CE. For detailed requirements, refer to the appropriate version of the *Sitecore CMS Installation Guide*. This guide is available in the documentation section of the Sitecore Developer Network (SDN) site, at

http://sdn.sitecore.net/Reference.aspx. You must log in to this site to access the documentation.

### What's New?

- You can now develop your own pipeline to determine which dependent items the Connector sends for translation when you select the Send dependent items check box in the Root of Source Items page in the Bulk Translation wizard. Previously, when this check box was selected, the Connector sent out only data source items of the item itself. It did not send out linked items.
- An administrator can now un-archive a job so that it is active again.
- The **Translation Queue** is now customizable. You can specify the number of items displayed per page and resize the window.
- You can now specify the following system settings in the /sitecore/system/Settings/Clay Tablet Settings folder in the content tree:
  - In the **Bulk Translation** section, you can select or clear the **Sync Translation Only send fields with changed content** check box to specify the value of the **Sync Translation** setting.
  - In the **Bulk Translation** section, you can select the default target languages to display in the **Settings** page of the **Bulk Translation** wizard.
- In the Root of the Source Items page of the Bulk Translation wizard, you can now select the Send selected root item only check box to send only the highlighted root item for translation without including its child items.

### Issues Fixed in This Release

Issue ID	Description
SIT-189	When using Clay Tablet's enhanced Workbox version 3.9.2 with the Connector version 3.9.2 and Sitecore 7 or 8, selecting a language in the <b>Language</b> dropdown list and clicking <b>Refresh</b> displayed content items in all languages. This issue has been resolved, so that selecting a language in the <b>Language</b> dropdown list and clicking <b>Refresh</b> now displays only content items in the selected language.
SIT-195	Previously, if you selected multiple items on multiple sub-pages in the Translation Queue and clicked Send Selected, then in the Send Items Out For Translation dialog box:  Only the items you selected on the current sub-page were displayed in the xxx items to send list.  The items you selected on the other sub-pages were displayed in the xxx more items in queue list.  This issue has been resolved. Now items you select on all sub-pages are displayed in the xxx items to send list.

Issue ID	Description
SIT-202	When using Sitecore 8, any workflow based on the Connector's TranslationWorkflow template was missing the new Default Comment Template and Default Comment Dialog Height fields. This occurred because the TranslationWorkflow base template was not compatible with Sitecore 8, which added these fields to the basic Workflow template. This issue has been resolved, because the TranslationWorkflow template now contains these two new fields.
SIT-207	The ClayTablet.Sitecore.PrimaryServer setting in the Website_root/Website/App_Config/Include/CT3Translation.config file is now case insensitive. This setting specifies the primary server when the Connector is running in a clustered environment of multiple load-balanced Sitecore servers. Previously this setting was case sensitive.
SIT-215	Previously, when running the Connector in a clustered environment of multiple load-balanced Sitecore servers, the primary server in the cluster could not sent out jobs for translation that were created on a secondary server. This issue has been resolved.
