Overview

Welcome to the Clay Tablet Connector for Sitecore (Connector). The Connector enables you to automate sending and retrieving content from your Sitecore CMS, which dramatically reduces the effort required to create, maintain, and publish Web content in multiple languages.

System Requirements

The Clay Tablet Connector for Sitecore (Connector) must be installed on the machine where Sitecore is installed. The Connector supports Sitecore versions 6.4 and higher, including all current releases.

The Connector has no additional hardware or software requirements beyond those of Sitecore CE. For detailed requirements, refer to the appropriate version of the *Sitecore CMS Installation Guide*. This guide is available in the documentation section of the Sitecore Developer Network (SDN) site, at http://sdn.sitecore.net/Reference.aspx. You must log in to this site to access the documentation.

The Connector supports the Mozilla Firefox and Google Chrome web browsers. The Connector supports Microsoft Internet Explorer 11 with Sitecore 7 and 8.

What's New?

- Previously, all messages about items that were not successfully sent for translation remained displayed at the top of the Content tab in the Sitecore Content Editor. Now, if a job has been archived, only Completed translation messages are displayed there.
- You can configure the default value of the Send Dependent Items check box in the Root of Source Item page of the Bulk Translation wizard. To configure the default value, in the /sitecore/System/Settings/Clay Tablet Settings folder in the content tree, in the Bulk Translation section, select or clear the Send dependent items check box.
- The Lionbridge OnDemand edition of the Connector now displays the ETA column instead of the Created column in the Translation Status window:
 - The **Created** column displayed the date that the content item was created.
 - The **ETA** column displays OnDemand's estimated date for translating a content item into a particular target language.
- The Connector documentation has been updated for Sitecore 8.

Issue ID	Description
SIT-137	A typo in the log file was corrected.
SIT-208	When using the Connector with Sitecore 8.1, the pagination controls were not displayed in the Translation Queue . This issue has been resolved.
SIT-210	 Previously, performing one of the following actions in the Translation Queue window displayed a The data could not be loaded message: resizing the window refreshing the queue sending selected items in the queue for translation This issue has been resolved.
SIT-212	Previously, if approximately 60 or more items were selected in the Translation Queue , clicking Send Selected displayed an error. This issue has been resolved.
SIT-214	Previously, the Connector used only the ItemPath and ignored the ItemId to identify an item it sent out for translation. This issue has been resolved, and the Connector now uses both the ItemPath and the ItemId to identify an item to send out for translation.

Issues Fixed in This Release

Issue ID	Description
SIT-219	Previously, if the Connector was configured to send out the Display Name field for translation (using the ClayTablet.TranslateDisplayName setting), then if there was no Display Name value, the Connector sent Sitecore's internal Name value instead. This caused a problem when importing the translated field, because it created a target Display Name value where there was no source Display Name value. This issue has been resolved: If there is no value in the Display Name field, then it remains blank.
SIT-223	The Backup translation projects check box in the Delete CTC Translation Backup Data page of the Translation Data Cleanup wizard was removed, because this feature is redundant. It has been replaced by the Archived jobs check box in the same page of the wizard.
SIT-231	Previously, a temporary Sitecore API failure prevented the Connector from completely sending out a job for translation. This issue has been resolved.
SIT-260	Previously, when a job was automatically submitted for translation, the delivery date (dueDate) in the metadata was incorrect. This issue has been resolved.

SIT-239	The Items per Page and Refresh user interface controls in the Workbox are not displayed properly in Sitecore 7.x.
