Overview

Welcome to the Clay Tablet Translation Connector for Sitecore ("Connector"). The Connector enables you to automate sending and retrieving content from your Sitecore CMS, which dramatically reduces the effort required to create, maintain, and publish Web content in multiple languages.

System Requirements

The Clay Tablet Translation Connector for Sitecore must be installed on the machine where Sitecore is installed. The Clay Tablet Translation Connector for Sitecore supports Sitecore versions 6.4 and higher, including all current releases.

The Clay Tablet Translation Connector for Sitecore has no additional hardware or software requirements beyond those of Sitecore CE. For detailed requirements, refer to the appropriate version of the Sitecore CMS Installation Guide. This guide is available in the documentation section of the Sitecore Developer Network (SDN) site, at http://sdn.sitecore.net/Reference.aspx. You must log in to this site to access the documentation.

What's New?

Sitecore users can now, in a single action, update a remote TM (translation memory) with changes to multiple items. To use this new feature, in the Translation Status window, click the **Update Remote TM** button to open the new Batch Remote TM Update wizard.

Issues Fixed in This Release

Issue ID	Description
SIT-86	The Connector can now send items for translation to different translation providers using different Clay Tablet Platforms, such as the hosted Platform and the On-Premise Platform. Previously, the Connector could not send items for translation to different translation providers using different Clay Tablet Platforms.
SIT-94	A user without read access to at least one language can now access the Language Selection window, from either the Bulk Translation wizard or the workflow interface. If the user selects a target language without having read access to it, an error message now indicates that the language code is mis-configured. This occurs because a user requires read access to a language to send out content for translation to that language. Previously, an exception occurred when a user without read access to at least one language accessed the Language Selection window, from either the Bulk Translation wizard or the workflow interface.
SIT-111	Updating a remote TM (translation memory) now sends changes to the translation provider who originally translated the content. Previously, updating a remote TM sent changes to the default translation provider.
SIT-112	Translation corrections are now delivered to the translation provider who originally translated the content. Previously, translation corrections were delivered to the default translation provider.
SIT-119	Sending out a translation job after preparing another job failed is now successful. Previously, after preparing a translation job failed, the user could not send out another translation job.
SIT-120	Viewing translated content using Sitecore's built-in preview page now displays both images and text. Previously, if the ClayTablet.PreviewURL setting in the CT3Translation.config file was configured, viewing translated content using Sitecore's built-in preview page displayed only images, not text.
