The Clay Tablet Connector for Sitecore must be installed on the machine where Sitecore is installed. The Clay Tablet Connector for Sitecore supports Sitecore versions 6.4 and higher, including all current releases.

The Clay Tablet Connector for Sitecore has no additional hardware or software requirements beyond those of Sitecore CE. SIT-147	<p>The global <code>ClayTablet.TranslateDisplayName</code> setting now properly supports sending out an item's display name for translation. The default value of this setting is now <code>false</code>. Previously, when this setting was enabled, the Connector copied the source item's display name field over the target item's display name field, which overwrote the translated value. Previously, the default value of this setting was <code>true</code>.</p>
