#### **Overview**

Welcome to the Clay Tablet Connector for Sitecore ("Connector"). The Connector enables you to automate sending and retrieving content from your Sitecore CMS, which dramatically reduces the effort required to create, maintain, and publish Web content in multiple languages

### **System Requirements**

The Clay Tablet Connector for Sitecore must be installed on the machine where Sitecore is installed. The Clay Tablet Connector for Sitecore supports Sitecore versions 6.4 and higher, including all current releases.

The Clay Tablet Connector for Sitecore has no additional hardware or software requirements beyond those of Sitecore CE. For detailed requirements, refer to the appropriate version of the Sitecore CMS Installation Guide. This guide is available in the documentation section of the Sitecore Developer Network (SDN) site, at <a href="http://sdn.sitecore.net/Reference.aspx">http://sdn.sitecore.net/Reference.aspx</a>. You must log in to this site to access the documentation.

### What's New?

- In the **Root of Source Item** page of the **Bulk Translation** wizard, the new **Send dependent items** check box enables you to send items dependent on selected content items out for translation. This is useful, for example, if a page item has multiple layers with different data sources, and you want to translate all the items displayed in the page.
- The Connector installation process has changed when using Microsoft SQL Server or Microsoft Azure. You now create an empty Microsoft SQL Server or Microsoft Azure database, and then the Connector installer creates the required tables in that database. This feature was previously available only with the Oracle database.

**Note:** The Connector installation package no longer includes empty Microsoft SQL Server and Microsoft Azure databases.

- The Sitecore Connector now supports configuring more than ten translation providers. Previously, the Sitecore Connector supported configuring a maximum of ten translation providers.
- In the Translate these items into the following Target Languages section of the Settings page of the Bulk Translation wizard, you can now click the Select All button to send content items for translation in all available languages.

### Issues Fixed in This Release

Issue ID	Description
SIT-144	Previously, the empty Microsoft SQL Server database included in the installation package could not be attached to Microsoft SQL Server 2014. This occurred because Microsoft SQL Server 2014 does not support compatibility level 90. The Connector installation package checked for compatibility level 90 and an error occurred if this requirement is not met.  Now, the installation package has been simplified so that it no longer includes empty databases. You can create an empty Microsoft SQL Server 2014 database separately. The Connector installer then creates the required tables in the database. This is also described in "What's New?" on page 2. For detailed instructions, refer to the relevant version of the Clay Tablet Connector for Sitecore Installation and Configuration Guide.
SIT-152	Clicking <b>Next</b> in the <b>Excluding Item(s)</b> page of the <b>Bulk Translation</b> wizard now always opens the <b>Translation Options</b> page, as expected. Previously, clicking <b>Next</b> in this page of the wizard sometimes opened the <b>Welcome</b> page instead. This occurred when some content items had been added to the list of items to translate multiple times, and the Connector did not detect and properly handle that scenario.
SIT-153	All instances of <b>CT3</b> in the graphical user interface (GUI) were changed to <b>CTC</b> (Clay Tablet Connector), because CT3 is a legacy branding term for the Connector.
